

CITY OF ST. MATTHEWS
ORDINANCE NO. 19-05, SERIES 2019
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
TIMES FOR SETTING OUT GARBAGE FOR COLLECTION IN CITY OF ST. MATTHEWS

WHEREAS, the City of St. Matthews Council has determined that setting out garbage, or garbage containers, too far in advance of the normal pickup, and/or failing to remove the garbage containers after emptying, is disruptive and a potential health and safety hazard for the City,

AND WHEREAS, the City desires for the health and welfare of the City to establish reasonable limits on setting out trash to better control the collection of garbage,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. MATTHEWS:

SECTION 1: A new Section of the City of St. Matthews codified ordinances is hereby adopted as follows:

50.01(F) It shall be unlawful to set out for curb-side collection, garbage, yard waste, recycling, large items, limbs, or junk more than 24 hours in advance of the normal collection date. Any carts, cans or containers must be moved back from the curb to the principal structure or garage within 24 hours after collection. Any garbage, yard waste, recycling, large items, limbs, junk, or anything else set out, but which was not collected, or refused for collection, must be removed from the curb and brought back to the residence within 24 hours of the pickup for which it was set out for collection. The City may grant additional time for items set out for "Bagster" type collection, as long as resident can show the "Bagster" was properly loaded, located properly for pickup and the collection company has been timely notified to make the pickup.

SECTION 2:

This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication according to law
